

## Arriving at School

### Caterpillars, Butterflies, Reception, Year 1 & Year 2:

Please use the KS1 gate, as before, which will be open from 8:40am until 8:55am (longer than previously)

*Please DO NOT arrive earlier than this and ensure you socially distance, even if you are required to queue to get through the gates and down the path*

### Miss Marsden, Mr Thompson, Mrs Gelder & Miss Isaure's classes:

Please use the KS2 gate, as before, which will be open from 8:40am until 8:55am

### Mrs Eden & Mrs Clarke's classes:

Please use the front entrance to school and the gate off the pavement, which will be open from 8:40am until 8:55am.

*If your child is in Years 5 or 6 and you feel they are able to safely, please allow them to walk to school on their own, therefore reducing the number of adults near school.*

Please DO NOT send your child to school if anyone in your house is displaying symptoms of Covid-19.

As was the case in the Autumn Term, school will not be providing snacks, apart from in Nursery. Please send your child with a snack. Packed lunches and water bottles may be sent from home.

## Leaving School

### Caterpillars, Butterflies, Reception, Year 1 & Year 2:

Please use the KS1 gate and collect your child at any point between 3:05pm and 3:20pm (longer than previously)

*Please DO NOT arrive earlier than this and ensure you socially distance, even if you are required to queue to get through the gates and down the path*

### All of KS2:

Please use the KS2 gate, as before, and socially distance on the playground where your child will be sent over to you by a member of staff. The gates will be open from 3:10pm to 3:20pm.

*If your child is in Years 5 or 6 and you feel they are able to safely, please allow them to walk home on their own, therefore reducing the number of adults near school. School will require permission to allow your child to do this, however. These pupils will leave through the main entrance/exit.*
