unvaccinated children can catch measles if someone in their class has it

Check your child is up to date with their MMR vaccinations

Due to an increase in measles cases across the country this year, including a recent outbreak in the West Midlands, we are encouraging everyone to check that they and their children have had 2 doses of the MMR vaccine.

The MMR vaccine is a free, safe and effective way to protect against measles, mumps and rubella.

If anyone is unsure about their child's vaccination status, or if they need to book a vaccine, they should contact their GP practice to check and book an appointment. There is no upper age limit for vaccination.

Measles spreads fast.

Anyone who is not vaccinated can catch it.

Measles can have serious and sometimes fatal consequences, so make sure you're up to date with #MMR vaccinations.
