Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to advise you that we have received confirmation that there are now 3 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Year 2B (Mrs Brook's class). We are aware that some other children are also awaiting PCR test results.

This now meets the threshold set by the Government and requires us to inform the Department for Education, to introduce some temporary, additional measures to reduce the risk of transmission, and to seek support and advice as necessary. 2B will therefore will not be mixing with other classes until they the outbreak is over. They will therefore also not be able to attend any clubs where they mix with other pupils, including before and after school clubs and Magic Breakfast.

All children and staff within the class are considered close contacts and we would advise you to arrange for your child to have a PCR test as soon as possible and to monitor your child closely for symptoms of COVID-19. The main symptoms of COVID-19 are the recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

Testing can be arranged at local walk in or drive through centres very easily, by booking online, by calling 119 or via the NHS website: www.nhs.uk/coronavirus. Please keep us informed of the result of the test. If your child remains well and symptom-free they should continue to attend school as normal, including while awaiting their PCR test result. It is also recommended that in addition to the PCR test, daily LFTs are undertaken each morning before school and children only attend when this is negative. This should be for a 10 day period.

Children who are at home will have access to learning via Seesaw, but they should only participate in the work if they feel well enough to do so. Please continue to stay in contact if your child is unwell so that we can offer you support as appropriate.
