Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to advise you that we have received confirmation that there are now 3 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Year 6 (Mr Thompson's class).

This now meets the threshold set by the Government and requires us to inform the Department for Education, to introduce some temporary, additional measures to reduce the risk of transmission, and to seek support and advice as necessary. 6T will therefore not be mixing with other classes, and Public Health have confirmed that this will be until the end of term. They will therefore also not be able to attend any clubs where they mix with other pupils, including before and after school clubs and Magic Breakfast. We apologise as we know how inconvenient this will be for some of our families.

All children and staff within the class are considered close contacts and we would advise you to arrange for your child to have a PCR test as soon as possible and to monitor your child closely for symptoms of COVID-19. The main symptoms of COVID-19 are the recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

Testing can be arranged by calling 119 or via the NHS website: [www.nhs.uk/coronavirus](http://www.nhs.uk/coronavirus). We request that the test is done at a local walk-in or drive-through centre, as the process of ordering, waiting for, administering and posting back the home test kits is adding up to 5 working days to each outbreak currently. Please keep us informed of the result of the test. If your child remains well and symptom-free they should continue to attend school as normal, including while awaiting their PCR test result.

Children who are at home will have access to learning via Seesaw, but they should only participate in the work if they feel well enough to do so. Please continue to stay in contact if your child is unwell so that we can offer you support as appropriate.
