SEPTEMBER PLANS

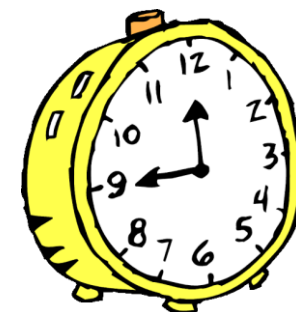
We are really looking forward to having all of our pupils back in for what we hope to be a fairly 'normal' start to the new academic year on Wednesday 2nd September.

Years 5 & 6 can walk home alone, but we need permission from parents



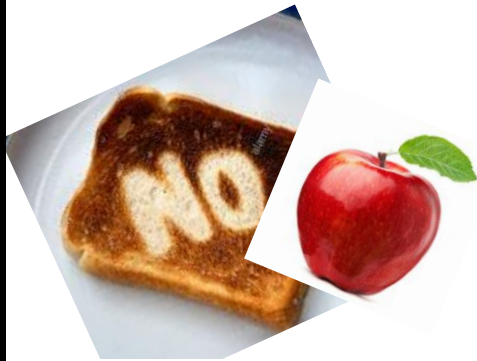
FREE Magic Breakfast will be in the hall from 8:20am daily from 2.9.20
