HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME

As has been shared via our Attendance Newsletter in September, and as explained on our website, the protocol for requesting a holiday in term time is to complete an absence request form, in advance of the holiday. In most circumstances, we are not able to authorise the holiday and often this results in a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) for parents on their return.

We have recently had an influx of holidays being taken without this form being completed and therefore school do not know where children are. **THIS IS A SAFEGUARDING RISK.** It is our statutory safeguarding duty to know where children are when they are not in school. Therefore, even if you are aware a request will not be authorised, **PLEASE INFORM SCHOOL IN GOOD TIME OF THE HOLIDAY,** so that we can acknowledge the absence and not have to ring you and make home visits whilst you are away. Not only does it disturb your holiday, but it also wastes staff time and, most importantly, causes us concern whilst we are not able to locate a child safely.
